

NO BUTTS ABOUT IT - CLEAN UP AUSTRALIA NEEDS YOU!

Clean Up Australia is calling on Aussies living in the north to help butt out Australia's litter problem by joining the Great Northern Clean Up.

Clean Up Australia Chair, Pip Kiernan said cigarette butts are consistently the most-littered item in the country, with up to 8.9 billion butts dropped each year. "When we think of plastic pollution we usually think of chip packets, drink bottles or straws, but cigarette butts are the most abundant plastic litter item in the world".

Ms Kiernan said the filters in most cigarettes are made of cellulose acetate, a type of plastic. "Cigarette butts are toxic plastic pollution. When littered, we're dumping not only that plastic, but also nicotine, heavy metals and other chemicals into the environment.

"By participating in the Great Northern Clean Up, we can get these butts and other litter out of the environment, before the wet season washes it into our waterways and out to sea."

Ms Kiernan said she is hopeful that the Great Northern Clean Up will help address the environmental impact of this litter issue but also offer Australians an important opportunity to reconnect with their communities.

"Clean Up Australia has always been more than just volunteers picking up rubbish. We're a community – and our community needs to connect and do something positive - for themselves and the environment".

Great Northern Clean Up is the northern sibling of Australia's largest environmental day of action, Clean Up Australia Day, and has been an annual event since 2009, giving northern communities the flexibility to participate in Clean Up events in the cooler months, after the peak tourist period and prior to the cyclone season.

Registration is free and participants are provided with gloves, bags and other resources, and covered by Clean Up Australia's public liability insurance.

Ms Kiernan said butts have consistently been the single most reported litter item by Clean Up Australia's volunteers, but noted that e-cigarettes or vapes are an emerging menace, creating a whole new stream of plastic and electronic waste. "E-cigarettes are an environmental triple threat – creating plastic waste, electronic waste and hazardous waste" she said.

ABOUT CIGARETTE BUTT LITTER

Littered butts pose a range of hazards and problems in natural environments. Cigarette filters are made from non-biodegradable plastic. Once littered, butts accumulate in the marine environment and leach toxic materials.2 They break up slowly, shedding microfibres and taking up to 15 years to decompose.3 Around one-third of nearly 100 chemicals that leach from cigarette butts are acutely or chronically toxic to aquatic species.4 Cigarette butts have been found in the stomachs of birds, turtles, whales and fish, where they affect digestion and potentially lead to poisoning or starvation.5
